A grand and historic brick home, reborn as an inn. Snapdragon Inn celebrates the beauty and bounty that Vermont and the Upper Valley have to offer.

Features of Snapdragon Inn include:

Nine private bedrooms, each with a private bathroom. Five queen and four king rooms are decorated in a simple and fresh style, and are outfitted for comfort and relaxation. Room features include custom bedding, air conditioning, wireless internet, and HD televisions. Bathrooms are tile and marble with radiant heat floors, and feature L'Occitane products.

The Dining Room serves a fresh continental breakfast to guests and is also available for private parties, luncheons, and dinners.

The Maxwell Perkins Library contains titles related to the history of the home and the works of its most famous residents. The library also contains a selection of board

games, and is a comfortable place to read or work, especially in the winter with a fire in the Vermont Castings stove.

Grounds include a large back porch for relaxing, a lawn and gardens, tree swing, and paths for exploring. Paradise Park borders the Snapdragon Inn and includes a lake for fishing, walking trails (both easy and more rugged) for strolling, running, or biking, and plenty of wildlife and birding opportunities.

LOCATION

Located in the heart of historic Windsor Vermont - the Birthplace of Vermont. Snapdragon Inn is part of the former Evarts Family Estate on Main Street and is within easy walking distance to museums, historic sites, restaurants, and shopping. The property borders Paradise Park, a local nature preserve that boasts hundreds of protected acres with a network of trails and Lake Runnemedede. Snapdragon Inn is also just five miles from Saint-Gaudens National Park, Harpoon Brewery and the Simon Pearce glass blowing factory and outlet store. Nestled in the

Upper Valley of Vermont & New Hampshire, Snapdragon Inn sits on the Connecticut River Byway and offers easy access to a number of iconic towns and scenic tours in the area.

ROOMS & RATES

9 rooms completed in 2010 during the overall renovation of the property. Each room offers a private bath. Double occupancy rates begin at \$219 with rates of \$379 in peak season.

ARCHITECTURE & STYLE

Completed circa 1815, the iconic building is a gable roofed 2.5 story brick structure with paired chimneys and racking parapets. The Snapdragon Inn renovation project lasted two years and was documented almost daily online. The project included a number of architectural preservation elements, as well as a design goal that sought to preserve the unique grand design of the interior of the home while also making it fresh and comfortable for current visitors. A unique blend of stunning, classic architecture with stylish decor and contemporary amenities, the inn now caters to savvy travelers. The grounds encompass over an acre of gardens and a connecting trail to Paradise Park nature preserve.

HISTORY

The home was constructed by John Skinner, and purchased soon after completion by William Maxwell Evarts who served as U.S. Attorney General, U.S. Senator from New York, and was a famous orator and lawyer in New York City. 26 Main Street was in the Evarts extended family until 2006 and also served as the residence and summer vacation home for Maxwell Perkins (grandson of William Maxwell Evarts) the editor of Ernest Hemingway, Thomas Wolfe, F. Scott Fitzgerald and others.

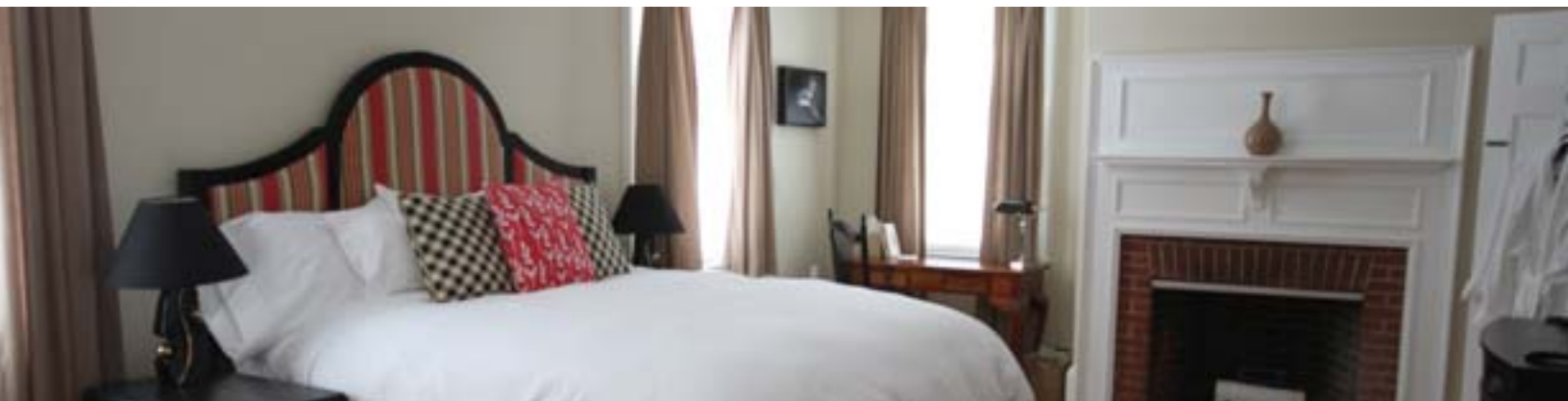
Perkins and his wife Louise Saunders were active members of the Cornish Colony which included artists Maxfield Parrish and Augustus St. Gaudens along with numerous writers, musicians, and painters. Saunders and Parrish authored and illustrated "Knave of Hearts" in Windsor, Vermont. More information can be found on the former owners on our official website.
